



## **License Options for Inlite Software**

**Description:** Describe the licensing policies for Inlite Research software.

### **Per CPU License**

Upon initialization, Inlite software modules look for licenses on the computer in which they are currently executing. If they do not find a license they will return an error code to the calling task. New installations have an evaluation period of 30 or 60 days (depending on the specific product) in which to acquire a license.

The license can be placed in two locations:

- On the computer itself
- On a USB Dongle(s)

The licenses are cumulative, in the sense that an OR function is performed on all the detected licenses and the maximum available product and feature set is enabled for the operator. For example, a PC license for ClearImage Repair, a dongle for ClearImage 1D Pro and a second dongle for ClearImage PDF417, would allow all three to be used on that PC. However the Licensing Manager shows the licenses for each product family on a separate panel, to make it easier to understand and see the results.

### **Multi Core Licenses**

The licenses can be purchased to support:

- A system with 1 or 2 cores – referred to as “Single or Dual Core”
- A system with 4 or more cores – referred to as “Quad Core”

The core count depends on what is available on the computer. Most servers are Quad Core, and require a Quad Core license.

Virtual Machines can be limited to execute on a subset of the cores, in that case a subset with 2 cores can utilize a Dual Core license.

### **License Installation**

The license can be installed by the end user or by an integrator. In both cases the process is similar.

- Following the purchase, certificates are emailed by Inlite Research. The certificates, constituting long strings of text, identify the purchased products, and carry a unit count. They can be installed as many times as their count

specifies. Excess installations are rejected by the Inlite License Database Server.

- The License Manager Application is executed on the target computer, and the certificate is entered into the text box ([See Support Note 11](#)). The certificates are cumulative, meaning that they add products to the installed collection of products on a particular computer.
- The license is registered via the internet by the License Manager into the Inlite License Database. At the conclusion of this step the license is fully functional.

## USB Dongles

Some customers prefer to store the license on USB Dongles. The dongles initially carry no licenses. If they are ordered at the same time as the licenses, then Inlite will ship them with the licenses installed. Otherwise, the licenses can be registered or transferred to the dongles later. Integrators may purchase a number of dongles in advance, and then issue them to customers as required.

## License Transfer

[Support Note 19](#) explains how to transfer the license of any product

- From the PC to the Dongle
- From the Dongle to the PC
- From one PC to another PC
- From Dongle to Dongle

The transfers require access to the internet in order to update the Inlite License Database. Licenses apply to specific products and can be transferred separately.

Once the request to transfer a license is submitted from a particular PC or Dongle, the license immediately ceases to be active.

## License Recovery

Recovering license for crashed or rebuilt computer is a support service. The license must be under support to receive this service. If the service is expired, then a License Recovery Service must be purchased, or the service must be brought up to date.
