



Inlite Licensing Procedures

This document describes how to use the Inlite Licensing Manager to manage all Inlite product licenses. Inlite licenses operate on one, particular computer or VM instance, to enable the operation of the licensed software on that particular computer or VM instance. Inlite's [Software Assurance Program](#) enables you to get a list of all your licenses, to recover lost licenses and to obtain new software releases.

The license management actions include:

- **Register** a license for production use on a target system.
- **Transfer** remove a license from one system or dongle and register onto another.
- **Recover** license information for a target system from the Inlite Registration Server
- **Version** select the particular production or development version

Terminology

The terminology of the licensing system includes:

- **Purchase Certificate** – is the long string of text delivered to the customer via email upon purchase of an Inlite Product. Unless you tell us otherwise, we issue a single certificate per order, which can register as many licenses as you purchased on that order. *Save the email with the Purchase Certificate in order to register additional licenses, or to transfer the license later, or for recovery.*
- **Transfer Certificate** – is the long string generated during the License Transfer procedure. It is displayed (not emailed) in the Licensing Manager of the old (from) computer, immediately after the transfer takes effect. It expires once the license is registered on new target system.
- **License** – is the information stored on a target system or on a dongle that authorizes the execution of a particular Inlite product.
- **Product Line** – is a functional group of Inlite's products. Licensing Manager Shows the licensed products in a particular Product Line.
- **Inlite Registration Server** – is the Online Database Server that maintains the list of all purchased products, valid certificates, and registered licenses.
- **Dongle** – is a USB device that can store the Licenses. Unlike licenses stored on a target system, it can be easily transferred between computers. *Unless you request otherwise, dongles purchased at the same time as the license are shipped with the license pre-installed.*

3. **(Option)** Select Product Line. The appropriate Product Line is automatically selected if the Licensing Manager is invoked from Windows Start menu. However, If you want to review or manage the licenses of other Product Lines on your computer, select a different one in the [Product Line selector](#) on the Toolbar.

4. **(Option)** Configure Proxy Settings. Licensing operations require access to Inlite Registration Server using HTTP protocol over port 80. If your system is connected to the Internet without a proxy, no extra configuration is required. For systems behind firewalls that use proxy servers, configure the Proxy setting in the pulldown [File menu -> Preferences](#) dialog box.

Performing Licensing Procedures

Initiate Licensing Action.

To register a license:

- Click the large **Register** button on the Toolbar.
- Enter the Certificate number in the **Registration** dialog box. Until the certificate text is completely entered, or if the number is incorrect, the certificate text will display in **red**, as shown below.

Once the entire certificate string is successfully entered, the product corresponding to the certificate is listed in the [Products To Register](#) box below.

- Repeat this procedure for each certificate that you want to register. You can

- also do this again later if necessary.
- Click on the **Register** button to complete the registration

To transfer a license:

- Select the product license that you want to transfer in the left panel's [Registered Products](#) section.
- Click **Transfer** button on Toolbar.
- (**Option**) When prompted, confirm if you want to transfer ALL the registered licenses from the current product line, and/or Enter additional certificate numbers

To complete license transfer: Upon completion of the Transfer action on the **old** system, the license becomes available for registration, and a transfer certificate is shown in the [Available Certificates](#) tab.

To register the transferred license on the new system:

- Select transferred license in left panel's [Available Certificates](#) on old system
- Click [Certificate to clipboard](#) in Actions pull down menu. Save the Transfer Certificate on the clipboard and transfer it to a **new** system via file, email, etc.
- Register the license on the **new** system using the registration procedure in this document, using the Transfer Certificate value.
NOTE: The Available Certificate will continue to show on the old system, till the next communication with Registration Server, even though it may no longer be valid.
NOTE: If you made a mistake and you want to re-register the license on the same **old** system, select the transferred license in left panel's [Available Certificates](#) on old system and just click **Register** button.

To recover licenses:

- License recovery resynchronizes your license with the Inlite Registration server. You can do this as many times as you like.
- Click Recover Licenses in Actions pull down menu.

Complete Licensing Action

What happens next, to complete the actions, depends on whether your computer is connected to the internet or not. In both cases, you can perform the registration, but the process is different.

If computer is online

The vertical line separating left and right panel turns **red** for few seconds, while communicating to Registration Serve. When the line turns **gray**, the action is completed.

If computer is offline

If the program is unable to contact the Inlite Registration Server, the Licensing

Manager prompts user to perform the Offline registration procedure.

Typically this procedure is required when the computer is isolated in secure facilities without Internet access.

Click the Continue button. A file named **NNNNN_CompName_request.lar** is created in the [My Documents](#) folder of the current user, and the user is notified.

Instructions on what to do with this file in order to complete the registration process are displayed in this window. Click the Done button, after you read them.

A [Pending Actions](#) section is created in the left panel.

Note: The offline instructions can be reviewed by clicking the [Show Offline Instructions](#) in the Offline pull down menu.
